#### Day 1 SPLIT (D)

Check-in at Split harbour from 14 h onwards. Enjoy our guided tour of Split, a historic town under UNESCO protection and a part of the world heritage - of special interest is the magnificent Diocletian palace, once inhabited by the Roman emperor. Return to the ship for a welcome cocktail and enjoy the meet & greet party on board. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 2 SPLIT - KORČULA (B, L)

Early morning departure towards Korčula Island, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays on route. Early afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this ancient town with fortified walls. Overnight in Korčula.

#### Day 3 KORČULA - MLJET/DUBROVNIK (B, L, D)

Next morning head further south to the Mljet Island. Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to the St Mary Isle to visit an ancient Benedictine monastery, an old abbey and a Church dating from the 12th Century. Return to the ship for lunch after which we depart towards Dubrovnik with late afternoon arrival. Before we tie the ropes at Gruž harbour the captain will take you for a dinner cruise alongside the old city walls. Enjoy the spectacular views of this magnificent old town. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

#### Day 4 DUBROVNIK (B)

A whole day to enjoy this magical town. After breakfast, transfer to the Old Town for the guided walking tour followed by a cable car ride from the Old Town to the Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the Walls and Elaphiti Islands enabling you to take the best pictures of the old town. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

#### Day 5 DUBROVNIK - PELJEŠAC PENINSULA (B, L, D)

Early morning departure towards the little seaside village on the Pelješac peninsula, well known for its excellent wine. Before lunch, a short stop at one of the Elaphiti Islands and afternoon arrival to Pelješac peninsula. Transfer to the village for a tour of the local church and monastery followed by a visit to a local farm to indulge in a typical village evening with Croatian delicacies, an allinclusive dinner with local dishes made from their own produce. Late transfer back to the ship. Overnight on Pelješac peninsula.

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#### Day 6 PELJEŠAC PENINSULA - HVAR (B, L)

Morning departure towards Hvar. Lunch stop on the small Island of Šćedro followed by a swim stop at the Pakleni Islands. Arrival to Hvar in the afternoon. Hvar is the longest island in the Adriatic and one of the sunniest; known for lavish lavender fields and breathtaking beauty. Join the guided walking tour. Overnight in Hvar.

#### Day 7 HVAR - BOL - MILNA or PUČIŠĆA (B, L, T, CD)

Today's destination is the Island of Brač and the picturesque town of Bol. Walk along the promenade or swim at one of the most famous beaches in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat (the Golden cape - known for its gravel promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change its shape). Bol is a typical fishermen's town turned into a popular tourist destination. After lunch on board time at leisure until Captain's farewell dinner with live entertainment on board. Overnight in nearby Milna or Pučišća.

### **ITINERARY**:

#### Day 1 SPLIT (D)

Transfer from Split airport to the Split harbour for check-in from 14h onwards. After settling, enjoy the guided tour of Split, a historic town under UNESCO protection and part of the world heritage with the magnificent Diocletian palace, once inhabited by the Roman emperor. After the tour, return to the ship for a welcome meet & greet cocktail reception on board. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 2 SPLIT - (BOL) HVAR (B, L)

Morning departure to Brač island where swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat near Bol. Continue towards the jet-set island Hvar with lunch on board at the Pakleni Islands. Hvar is the longest and sunniest island in the Adriatic known for lavish lavender fields and breathtaking beauty. Afternoon arrival followed by a tour of the town's historical landmarks. Hike up to the town fort and enjoy abundance of entertainment in the evening hours. Overnight in the port.

#### HVAR - BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE) Day 3 / VIS (B, L, T)

Early morning cruise towards the small island Biševo to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon (depending on the weather conditions). Continue to the island of Vis, once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and closed to the public. Try some exquisite wine sorts in one of the local traditional wineries. Overnight in the port of Vis.

#### Day 4 VIS - KORČULA (B, L)

Early morning departure towards the Korčula island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour. Optional excursion to a small village near Korčula for a typical Dalmatian dinner and to find out more about the history and traditional way of living. Overnight in Korčula.

#### KORČULA - MLJET (B, L) Day 5

Morning cruise further south to the Island of Mljet. Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to the St Mary Isle to visit an ancient Benedictine monastery dating back to the 12th Century. Alternatively, rent kayaks, bicycles, scooters or convertible cars to roam around the island on your own. Overnight in the port Polača or Pomena.

#### Day 6 MUJET -SLANO(STON) (B, L, T, CD)

Departure for a small village called Slano on the mainland, a peaceful fishermen's village and the starting point to Ston, another, once fortified small village famous for its oysters. After exploring the town's medieval ramparts, a short coastal walk leads to an oyster farm to learn more about oysters and tasting this delicious treat. Transfer to the ship for the Captain's dinner with live entertainment on board and overnight in Slano.

#### Day 7 SLANO(STON) - DUBROVNIK (B, L)

Early morning departure to Dubrovnik. The special charm of this ancient town are the buildings that have remained from the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. Before tying the ropes at Gruž harbour, cruise alongside the old Dubrovnik city walls while lunch is served on board. After docking, transfer to the old town for the guided walking tour of this magical town ending with the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the Walls and Elaphiti Islands. Time at leisure for dinner and overnight in Dubrovnik.

#### DUBROVNIK (B) Dav 8

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## Departures from Split

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A well-balanced combination of exceptional natural beauty and cultural heritage, this route is made for passionate travellers. Charming islands, stunning bays with pebble beaches, emerald green, clean sea, preserved nature of a national and a nature park, sights of mountains, canyons, waterfalls and abundance of historical monuments with masterful architecture. No room for stress, northern Dalmatia with its gems is waiting to impress.













Check-in is followed by departure from Split harbour at 14.00h. Enjoy a welcome cocktail and unbelievable views of the surroundings while cruising towards Trogir followed by a swim stop. Trogir is one of the most beautiful and artistically inspired towns of the world, often also called "miniature Venice" - it is 3000 years old and its old centre is a protected UNESCO heritage site. Early dinner and overnight on board in Trogir.

#### Day 2 TROGIR - SKRADIN - NATIONAL PARK KRKA WATERFALLS - ŠIBENIK - (B, T)

Wake up and admire the scenic views as the cruise proceeds north, while having a wonderful breakfast. Upon arrival to Skradin, visit the winery for wine tasting and light tapas lunch. Back in Skradin, walk through the Krka Waterfalls National Park. There are 17 waterfalls, with cascades up to 100 m wide, and the Krka river tumbles 45.7 meters. The late afternoon destination is Šibenik, a town situated in the very central part of Croatia's Adriatic coast. Join the guided sightseeing tour to explore the glorious old town, the cultural monuments and possibly the most famous one here, the UNESCO listed Cathedral of St James. Wander around and discover the historic core and waterfront. Overnight in Šibenik.

#### Day 3 ŠIBENIK - NATIONAL PARK KORNATI - TELAŠĆICA NATURE PARK (B, L, D)

Cruise continues towards the majestic Kornati islands that is actually made up of 100 islands and reefs. This is really something remarkable to see as inlets on some islands descend steeply into the sea, a hundred meters deep in places, and are dramatically razor sharp. There are ruins of the old Illyrian fortress, Roman villas, the old Christian church of St. Mary and medieval fortresses and settlements among these islands. Enjoy a swim stop before arrival at Telašćica Nature Park, with its breathtaking cliffs plunging into the azure waters below, creating a stunning natural spectacle. Dinner and overnight in Telašćica.

#### Day TELAŠĆICA NATURE PARK - MALI LOŠINJ (B, L)

After breakfast and a morning swim, cruise towards the island of Lošinj, known as the

sunshine island. An abundance of pines, wildflowers and herbs, its excellent climate, hidden coves and cool Mediterranean vibe all of this makes Lošinj one of the most popular islands on the northern Adriatic. Join a guided walking tour, followed by a visit to the Museum of Apoxyomenos. The museum is dedicated to the ancient bronze statue of an athlete found in the sea near the island. Walk up to the Lošinj Aromatic Garden or to the smaller town of Veli Lošinj both easy to reach and explore on foot. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

#### Day 5 MALI LOŠINJ - ZADAR (B, L)

Morning cruise towards Zadar, travelling by Pag island with its unusual moon-like landscape. Upon arrival in Zadar, join a guided tour to explore the rich cultural heritage: the Roman Forum from the 1st century AD, the church of St. Donatus from the 9th century AD - the most famous medieval basilica and symbol of the city, the imposing and mighty city walls with the representative Port and Land Gates from the 16th century AD, and numerous palaces and villas of former noble families. Great restaurants line part of the waterfront and the centre. See the famous contemporary attractions: the Sea Organ, one of a kind in the world and "The Greeting to the Sun" light installation. Overnight in Zadar.

#### Day 6 ZADAR - VODICE - PRIMOŠTEN (B, L, CD)

Early morning cruise towards Vodice, a lively place in the high season. Enjoy a brief stop and take a stroll along the wonderful beaches of this typical Dalmatian town. Cruise towards the picturesque Primošten, a typical small Dalmatian coastal town, well known for its quality local wines. Lunch on board followed by a swim stop. Enjoy the evening in this fascinating, picturesque small town, and taste some local wines. Captain's dinner with live music on board, in the evening. Overnight in Primošten.

#### Day 7 PRIMOŠTEN - SPLIT (B, L)

Morning cruise towards Split. Lunch served on board. Enjoy unbelievable views of the surrounding seas and the amazing Split Riviera. Upon arrival, join the guided city tour. A dynamic port city with a medieval Old Town grown around the 1.700-year-old Diocletian's Palace, Split bustles with modern life amid its ancient Roman setting. Cafés, restaurants, and galleries cram the cobblestone alleyways, the waterfront and the Marjan peninsula, making Croatia's second-largest city one of the Mediterranean's most compelling. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 1 SPLIT - PUČIŠĆA (BRAČ) (D)

Transfer from the Split airport to the Split harbour. Check-in from 13.00 h onwards. Meet the crew and enjoy a welcome cocktail while we set sail for the first island on the route towards the island of Brač, the largest island in Dalmatia, known for the precious white stone used in famous buildings like the White House, Diocletian's Palace and the Budapest Parliament to name a few. The village Pučišća has always been known for its culture of stone masonry. The harmony and homogeneousness of the plebeian houses, the Renaissance palaces and Baroque buildings made from the white stone of Brač, leave every visitor breathless. Visit the stone masonry workshop, one of a few left in Europe. Dinner on board and overnight in Pučišća.

#### Day 2 PUČIŠĆA - KORČULA (B, L)

In the morning, after breakfast, cruise towards the Island of Korčula, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Early afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this enchanting town, fortified by the walls. The island treasures many legends, myths and tales. Discover mystical Korčula, through a magic chest of traditions while wandering along the herringbone pattern streets. The town has an abundant choice of restaurants offering an awesome gourmet experience and also numerous bars and clubs for evening entertainment. Overnight in Korčula.

#### Day 3 KORČULA - MLJET (B, L, CD)

Morning cruise further south towards the Island of Mljet. The legend says, Greek hero Odysseus spent years on this island. During his travels, he was captured by the nymph Calypso and spent years with her in the cave right here, on Mljet. Enjoy one of the greenest islands of the Adriatic and beware of the nymphs... Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to the St Mary Isle, visit the ancient Benedictine monastery, an old abbey and a Church dating from the 12th Century. Mljet is a quiet and protected area, enjoy the serenity, the nature and relax your senses. It is home to many endemic plant species and a rich historical heritage. There are many options for different activities, rent a bike or a kayak for leisure time to explore. In the evening a Captain's dinner with live entertainment on board. Overnight in Pomena or Polača port.

#### Day 4 MLJET - LASTOVO (B, L, T, D)

After breakfast, departure towards Lastovo, the largest island of the archipelago of the same name. Lastovo was a military base for Yugoslavian Army and therefore closed for tourism till 1989. That is one of the reasons why the island kept its natural wooded beauty and sense of isolation. The central town of the island is located inland, which is very unusual for the islands, this is because the inhabitants had to hide from the pirates who tried to conquer this island many times during the past. After lunch on board, there will be a transfer to Lastovo town, a very picturesque place with old stone houses set on a slope. Wine tasting at the local winery. Dinner on board and overnight in the port.

#### Day 5 LASTOVO - VIS (B, L)

Today's destination is the island of Vis, lately known as the filming location of Mamma Mia 2. Enjoy the lunch on board as the vessel approaches Vis. Time at leisure to explore the main filming locations around the island: the Vis harbour, the Barjoška bay, the market, Barjaci - where the big Abba performance was filmed and many, many others. It is possible to rent scooters/cars to visit the rest of the island on your own. Plenty of beautiful sights and dining places to discover in the evening. Overnight in Vis.

#### Day 6 VIS - BIŠEVO - (BLUE CAVE)/ HVAR / STARI GRAD (B, L)

Visit the small island Biševo and its famous Blue Cave, a splendorous and unique geomorphological natural wonder. hypnotizing silver-blue light illuminates the space inside the cave (entrance fee to be paid on the spot). The visit will depend on weather & tide conditions. Cruise continues towards Hvar, the sunniest Adriatic Island and the jetset destination. Upon arrival, time at leisure to explore Hvar, walk through the smooth cobblestone streets, check out the oldest communal theatre in Europe (set above the "Arsenal" at the local square), or just take a cup of coffee at one of many terraces and feel the vibe. A bus will be ready for the excursion with lunch to Stari Grad, the oldest town in Croatia! The first settlers were the Greeks from the island Paros in the Aegean Sea, who established the colony in the year 384 B.C. and named the town Pharos. Learn more on a guided tour. Overnight in Stari Grad.

#### Day 7 STARI GRAD - BOL (BRAČ) / SPLIT (B, L)

Wake up early to admire the sunrise while enjoying the hearty breakfast. Relax on a sundeck and enjoy a swim stop at the most famous beach in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat near Bol - whose shingle promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly cause the shape to change. After lunch, as the cruise continues towards Split, enjoy the unbelievable views of the surrounding seas and the amazing Split's Riviera. Upon arrival, join the guided city tour. A dynamic port city with a medieval Old Town grown around the 1.700-yearold Diocletian's Palace, Split bustles with modern life amid its ancient Roman setting. Cafés, restaurants, and galleries cram the cobblestone alleyways, the waterfront and the Marjan peninsula, making Croatia's secondlargest city one of the Mediterranean's most compelling. Overnight in Split.



Morning cruise from Rab towards Zadar, travelling by Pag island with its unusual moonlike landscape. We stop to swim on tiny Maun island. In Zadar, there is a guided tour of the city which is the centre of the region and was the metropolis of Dalmatia region for many centuries. The rich cultural heritage is visible at every turn: The Roman forum which dates to the 1st century AD, the church of St. Donatus dating to the 9th century AD - the most famous Medieval basilica and the symbol of the city. The imposing and mighty city walls with representative Port and Land gates are from the 16th century AD, and there are numerous palaces and villas of former noble families. Great restaurants line part of the waterfront and the centre of town. Famous contemporary creations are the Zadar Sea Oraan, one of a kind in the world (listen to the sound) and "The Greeting to the Sun" light installation. Overnight in Zadar.

#### Day 4 ZADAR - KORNATI (B, L, D)

Today we visit the region of the famous National Park Kornati - rich in fish and cultural and historic remains. Historic remains of the old Illyrian fortress, Roman villas, old Christian church of St. Mary and medieval fortresses and settlements add to the value of these islands. Kornati consists of 140 islands and reefs. Inlets of some islands descend steeply into the sea, a hundred meters deep in places, and dramatically razor sharp. It is truly something remarkable to see. Dinner onboard and overnight in Telašćica Bay on Dugi Otok. Possibility to walk to the white cliffs vertically falling down 90 m into the sea and rising up to 200 m over the sea as well as the salt lake "Mir".

#### Day 5 KORNATI - MALI LOŠINJ (B, L)

After breakfast and a morning swim, we cruise towards Lošinj known as "sunshine island" an an abundance of pines, wild flowers and herbs. Lošinj is one of the most popular islands on the northern Adriatic waters for its hidden coves and cool Mediterranean vibe. On arrival to Mali Lošinj, enjoy a walking tour followed by a visit to the Museum of Apoxyomenos. The museum is dedicated to the ancient bronze statue of an athlete found in the sea near the island. Walk up to the Lošinj Aromatic Garden or to the smaller town of Veli Lošinj both are easy to reach and explore on foot. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

We leave for Cres island after our morning swim. Possible swim stop on island Susak, if weather permits. This unspoiled island is long and narrow with olive groves, vineyards, forests of oak, beech and remarkable stone walls. Cres and Mali Lošinj were once one island before the Romans dug a narrow channel to separate them. Optional dinner in village Loznati (with transfer from Cres) where you can try the best traditional lamb specialities this island has to offer. Alternatively, spend the night in the harbour of this typical medieval town - Cres - with Cres with hidden squares and courtyards.

#### Day 7 CRES - OPATIJA (B, L, CD)

After breakfast, we leave for Opatija. The famous Opatija Riviera is best seen from the sea. We arrive in the late afternoon. Stroll the longest seaside promenade in Croatia called Lungomare or stop in Volosko, a traditional fishing village. On your last night, enjoy Captain's dinner with live entertainment on board. #### Day 1 OPATIJA - RAB (L, T)

Departure at 13h towards Rab, known as the "island of love", with an old town of the same name. Guided city tour includes the medieval walls, the famous four towers together with palaces, churches and squares. There is a slight Montmartre feel with many artists painting and exhibiting out on the streets. Legend has it that local nuns created a special Rab cake for a visiting Pope and we will sample this after the tour. The recipe remains forever a secret. Overnight in Rab.

#### Day 2 RAB - ZADAR (B, L)

After breakfast head for Zadar, the oldest university town in Croatia with an amazing heritage and where history looks into the eyes: the Roman Forum from the 1st century, St Donat church from the 9th century - the most famous medieval Basilica and the city's symbol, the mighty city walls, over 30 churches. Museums and former noble families' palaces and villas in the old town. In recent years Zadar has added a touch of cool with the famous Sea Organs and "Greeting to the Sun" light installations, both located on the city's waterfront. Watch the fabulous sunset from here.

#### Day 3 ZADAR - KRKA WATERFALLS / ŠIBENIK (B, T, D)

Wine and waterfalls! Cruise towards Skradin. The first stop is the local winery for wine tasting and light tapas lunch followed by a walk through the Krka Waterfalls National Park and a visit to "Skradinski Buk". Jaw-droppingly beautiful, this is the most popular part of the waterfall area. There are 17 waterfalls, with cascades up to 100 m wide, and the Krka river tumbles 45.7 meters. Šibenik is almost in the very central part of Croatia's Adriatic coast and it is our afternoon destination. Explore the glorious old town, the cultural monuments and possibly the most famous one here, the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St James. Wander and discover the historic core and waterfront of Šibenik and enjoy some shopping too. Dinner on board.

#### Day 4 ŠIBENIK - SPLIT (B, L)

Cruise south to Split, Croatia's second-largest city, where Roman Emperor Diocletian built a retirement palace now under UNESCO protection. Split waterfront is a happening place and there's a buzz along the beautiful wide promenade. A local guide meets us on arrival for a walk through the heart of the bustling old town and the market. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 5 SPLIT - METKOVIĆ (B, L, CD)

Today, discover one of the last remaining wetland deltas in Europe. Cruise to Metković, on the banks of the river Neretva after which the delta is named. Here, mandarins grow by the water channels. Take a barge ride to explore the groves, flora and fauna, wild birds and the traditional way of life of the Neretva people. There is a delightful, "time warp" feeling like nowhere else on the coast. Visit Narona, the archaeological museum in Vid, formally inaugurated in 2007 as the first "in situ" museum in Croatia. Narona holds the remains of a Roman temple - the Augusteum and seventeen monumental marble sculptures of Roman emperors and their family members. This is where the ancient Illyrians, Greeks, and Romans once sailed, and, according to legend, the pirates of Neretva planned their raids on enemy galleys. Captain's dinner with live entertainment on board is scheduled for this evening.

#### Day 6 METKOVIĆ - KORČULA (B, L)

Departure towards Korčula, an island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo, the famous explorer. Covering much of the island are the distinct, almost black pine forests so Korčula is also known as "the Black Island". Korčula Town is often called mini Dubrovnik, as it is also encased by medieval stone ramparts and towers. The famous Moreška sword dance-fight is thought to have come to the island when the Moors raged through this region and there are regular performances. A local guide will lead you through the old town where tiny streets are designed in a fishbone pattern for a very good reason that you will hear about! Lots of simple konobas, restaurants and cool cocktail bars for chill-out time. Overnight in Korčula.

#### Day 7 KORČULA - DUBROVNIK (B, L)

There is no better way to catch the first sight of the famous town of Dubrovnik - than approaching from the sea. It is one of the few walled cities on the sea in the world. Writer George Bernard Shaw described it as "heaven on earth". Cruise alongside the old city walls

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for a true perspective of its majesty. Lunch is served on board as we head for Gruž harbour to dock. Once moored, join a transfer to the Old Town for a guided walking tour. Take the cable car from the Old Town to the Srđ mountain for fabulous views of the city itself and the Elaphiti Islands. Time at leisure to walk those famous, 1940 metres long ramparts, or explore any of the museums in detail, such as Sponza or Rectors. Overnight in Dubrovnik.



#### Day 1 DUBROVNIK (D)

Transfer from Dubrovnik airport to Dubrovnik Gruž harbor for Check-in from 14h onwards. After settling in, transfer to the city gates for a guided tour of the city. The special charm of this ancient town are the buildings that remain from the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. Many of the monuments belong to the modest Renaissance architecture with some traces of Gothic style. Take the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the mighty ramparts and of the Elaphiti Islands. After the tour, join a return transfer to the ship for a welcome / meet & greet cocktail reception on board. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

#### Day 2 DUBROVNIK - PERAST -KOTOR (B, L)

After breakfast head to the town of Kotor. As we are traveling from one country to another, there will be some formalities at the border. Upon arrival join a transfer to Perast (approximately 30 min) by bus. In Perast, take a small boat to visit the artificial island Our Lady of the Rock, the church known for its tablet collection and magnificent paintings. The magnificent Cathedral of St. Triphun was built in 1166. on the ruins of the temple of the 9th century and is a beautiful example of sacred architecture. The Old City of Kotor is a well preserved urbanization typical of the Middle Ages. Many other monuments include numerous churches and palaces and Napoleon's Theatre from the 19th century. Overnight in Kotor.

#### Day 3 KOTOR - BUDVA - CETINJE -NJEGUŠI - KOTOR (B, L, D)

A morning coach excursion to Budva. Visit old town ramparts and citadel that are bordered by the waves of the Mediterranean. Budva is the capital of the Montenegrin Riviera with its 21 km long coast and numerous beaches. Old town of Budva lies on a small peninsula and represents a treasure chest of cultural heritage. Crossed with narrow streets and squares are famous buildings such as the St. Trojica Church. Departure towards the old royal Cetinje, magical city at the foot of Mount Lovćen, the historical, cultural and spiritual capital of Montenegro. Guided visit of the city with entrance to the King Nikola's museum. Continue towards Njeguši, cradle of Montenegrin royal family. Lunch in a traditional restaurant, tasting local ham and cheese with red wine. Continue towards the coast, driving by the old serpentine road overlooking Boka Bay. Return to Kotor, where your vessel awaits. Dinner on board, overnight in Kotor.

#### Day 5 ŠIPAN - KORČULA (B, L)

In the morning, the cruise continues towards the Island of Korčula, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this enchanting town with fortified walls. #### Day 1 SPLIT - MAKARSKA (L)

Departure at 13h from the Split harbour. Cruise along the Dalmatian coast toward Makarska while enjoying lunch. Overnight in Makarska, the famous tourist destination with many restaurants and bars and a beautiful promenade along the famous beach.

#### Day 2 MAKARSKA - BOL (BRAČ) - STARI GRAD (B, L)

Early departure toward Korčula, the birthplace of the famous explorer and adventurer Marco Polo. Surrounded by medieval walls, Korčula resembles a miniature Dubrovnik when approached from the sea. It treasures more legends, tales and monuments than any other place. Overnight in the port.

#### Day 6 KORČULA - MLJET - ŠIPAN or SLANO (B, L, CD)

After breakfast, cruise toward one of the greenest Adriatic islands - the island of Mljet, where on the western part, the National Park is situated (entrance fee to be paid on the spot). Explore and enjoy the beauties of the National Park on foot or by cycling around, canoeing or swimming in the lakes. Afternoon cruise towards Sipan, part of the Elaphite islands near Dubrovnik, or Slano on the coastline, both small fishermen's villages. Captain's dinner on board and overnight.

#### DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (18 km)

Arrival in Opatija and check-in at Opatija harbour from 11h. Departure at 13h followed by lunch on board on route to the island of Krk. During the cruise, you will have the opportunity to meet other passengers and the crew. Easy ride from the town of Krk to the village of Punat and back to Krk town. Overnight.

#### Day 2 KRK (B, D)

#### DIFFICULTY LEVEL 4 (48 km)

After breakfast, cycle through Mediterraneanscented vegetation, olive groves and fig trees to the village of Dobrinj - a real town museum, a synthesis of past and present. Ride through the dry-stone walls and flocks of sheep to the biggest field on the island - Vrbnik's field with its famous golden yellow wine Žlahtina. Rest in Vrbnik while tasting wine, cheese and prosciutto. Continue to the saddle Treskavac with the wonderful view of Punat valley and the small island of Košljun with a Franciscan monastery dating from the 12th century. Downhill through Bašćanska Draga to Baška, getting to know the sculptures of Glagolitic letters. Dinner on board overnight in Baška. Remark: In case of bad weather conditions (bura wind), end of tour and overnight in Krk.

#### Day 3 KRK - RAB (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (22 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (21 km)

During breakfast, the ship cruises to Lopar on the island of Rab - the second greenest croatian island. The bike tour leads to a famous sandy beach bay. Cycle through the interior of the island, past wonderful Supetarska Draga in the direction of the ancient walled city of Rab with its four famous bell towers situated on an arrow shaped spit of land. After lunch on board, cycle to the nature reserve 'Dundo' forest - one of the few surviving forests in the Mediterranean, which extends over the Kalifront peninsula. Swimming break in the picturesque bay St.Mara. Overnight in the port of Rab.



After a short crossing to the island of Pag, start a bike tour along the island's beautiful moon-like landscape. First stop is the village of Lun with thousand years old olive trees and many stone walls. Be careful when cycling on this island due to many wandering sheep. The island is famous for its Pag cheese. We highly recommend a break in a traditional 'konoba' tavern to taste the cheese. In the idyllic village of Mandre, return to the ship for lunch on board. Cruise to llovik, an island full of flowers, with time at leisure to walk, swim and relax. Optional Captain's dinner on board with overnight in llovik.

#### Day 5 ILOVIK - MALI LOŠINJ (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (20 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (21 km)

After breakfast, departure towards Mali Lošinj. Bike tour through the lovely Čikat peninsula surrounded by pine trees and Mediterranean herbs while enjoying the beautiful beaches. Continue to the picturesque village Veli Lošinj and back to the ship for lunch. Afternoon easy ride to one of the beaches or to the Sveti Ivan hill (250m) or the theme viewpoint Providenca where you can enjoy fantastic views of the city and the southern part of the Lošinj archipelago.

#### Day 6 MALI LOŠINJ - CRES (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (46 km)

After breakfast, cycle through the pine and laurel trees towards Cres island (connected to Mali Losinj by small bridge). First stop in the artistic village of Osor, followed by a more strenuous cycling towards the fishing village of Martinšćica where lunch will be served on board. Afternoon cruise towards the historic town of Cres for a free evening and overnight.

#### Day 7 CRES - OPATIJA (B, L)

#### DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (20 km)

During breakfast, the ship departs for Mošćenička Draga on the Opatija riviera. This guided cycling tour in Dalmatia starts on Brač island and ends on the island of Šolta, exploring amazing coastlines, medieval towns, old villages and picturesque bays. Highlights include visiting great beaches, vineyards, and pine woods, cycling on the historic islands and exploring Mljet National Park.







#### Day 1 SPLIT - SUPETAR - PUČIŠĆA (L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (25 km)

Arrival in Split and check-in from 11h. Departure at 13h followed by lunch on board on journey to the island of Brač. Upon arrival in Supetar, cycle the coastal road to the northern part of the island of Brač. Passing by the fishing villages Splitska and Postira and arrive in one of the most beautiful small settlements in Europe -Pučišća. Free afternoon for sightseeing of this charming town well known for its long stonemason tradition. Overnight in Pučišća

#### Day 2 PUČIŠĆA - POKRIVENIK / JELSA - SUĆURAJ - LOVIŠTA / KUČIŠTE (B, L, CD)

#### DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (32 km)

Breakfast and morning sail towards the longest Croatian island - Hvar with the view of Biokovo mountain. Today's starting point is a small picturesque bay Pokrivenik. Starting with the ascend to the highest point of the route and descend to the eastern point of Hvar island - Sućuraj, where the vessel is waiting. After lunch on board, sail towards the second biggest Croatian peninsula Pelješac and a charming settlement Lovišta or Kučište. Optional Captain's dinner on board (included on Premium categories). Overnight.

#### Day 3 KUČIŠTE - TRSTENIK (B, D) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 4 (30 km)

The third-day ride could be called the winepanoramic route. After breakfast, start riding towards Orebić, the city of seafarers and captains. The first few kilometers of ascending followed by descending with the unique viewpoints on Korčula archipelago. After Orebić, ascend to the area where the most famous varieties of Croatian wine succeed. Cross the tunnel Dingač to the south side of Pelješac and continue riding through vineyards to Trstenik. Overnight in Trstenik.

#### Day 4 TRSTENIK - MLJET -KORČULA (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (18 km)

Cruise during breakfast from Trstenik to Mljet island, the lush green island also known as Honey island. Mljet National park (entrance fee to be paid on the spot) is a beautiful area of unique charm featuring two connected salt water lakes, a lush flora, a unique appearance of indented coastline, cliffs and numerous islets as well as always green plants of the surrounding hills. Cycle around the saltwater-lake, inside which there is another island with the Benedictine monastery from the 12th century. Refreshment in saltwater lakes and return to lunch on board. Sail to Korčula. Free afternoon for exploring the town of Marco Polo. Overnight in Korčula.

#### Day 5 KORČULA - VELA LUKA (B, D) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 4 (55 km)

After breakfast, start with the longest route of the week through the whole island of Korčula. Ascend to Žrnovo village and then to the oldest settlement on the island - Pupnat, the highest point of the route. Descend to the south side of Korčula and road ride between one of the most beautiful bays on the island with steep cliffs above it. Continue the ride through numerous olive groves and vineyards, one of the most famous grape varieties Pošip. Short break in the charming place Smokvica, half the way. Descend to the sea and stop for refreshment in one of the numerous hidden pebble beaches. Ascend towards the viewpoint above town Blato, followed by the final descent towards our goal - Vela Luka. Dinner on board and overnight in Vela Luka.

#### Day 6 VELA LUKA - HVAR -STARI GRAD (B, L)

#### DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (23 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (22 km)

Early morning sail from Vela Luka to the



town of Hvar, breakfast. Short sightseeing of Hvar, a fairy tale city with its architecture, beautiful nature and mild climate. Cycle from Hvar to the other side of the island -Stari Grad. Pass through numerous lavender plants and enjoy the view towards the neighbouring islands and mainland. Lunch on board in Stari Grad. Easy afternoon ride up to two Hvar's pearls - Jelsa and Vrboska and through Stari Grad Plain where the ancient Greek land division has been preserved to these days like the system of roads and plots. Overnight in Stari Grad.

#### Day 7 STARI GRAD - STOMORSKA -SPLIT (B, L)

#### DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (36 km)

The last day starts with a cruise from Stari Grad to the island of Šolta. After breakfast, cycle from Stomorska to the highest point of the island - Gornje Selo, enjoying the views on both sides of the island and scents of Mediterranean plants. Continue to Maslinica on the west part of the island. Short break and return to Stomorska. Lunch on board and sail to Split. Free afternoon for sightseeing in Split, a city of UNESCO. Discover endless layers of history, architecture and urban spirit. Overnight in Split.

The route runs through two islands. After breakfast, cruise from Zadar to Ugljan - the sunniest island in Zadar archipelago. The route starts in Preko and leads along the coastline to Kali and then to Kukljica. The islands Ugljan and Pašman are connected by the bridge. Pašman is the island without frontiers, the island of joy and happiness, of little people with big hearts. Arrival to Tkon where the ship awaits. Sail towards Vodice with the great view of the pearls of Kornati islands. Overnight in Vodice.

#### Day 5 VODICE - SKRADIN - ŠIBENIK (B, D)

Dinner on board and overnight in Šibenik.

Free afternoon in Split for a walking tour. Overnight in Split.



### **ITINERARY:**

#### Day 1 SPLIT - SUPETAR (L)

Check-in and departure at 13h. Lunch during the journey to the island of Brač and time to meet fellow passengers and the crew. Upon arrival in Supetar, a hiking tour for warming up! Supetar is the island's capital and it's the only city on the island, developing fast in the past few years. Overnight in Supetar.

Walking time: approx. 1,5 hours.

#### Day 2

Breakfast during the sail from Pučišća to Makarska. After arrival, transfer to the mountain hut 'Pod Vošcem' where the hiking tour to the highest peak of Biokovo, and at the same time the second highest Croatian peak - Sveti Jure (1762 m) starts. ## ITINERARY: FROM OPATIJA

#### Day 1 OPATIJA - BAŠKA OR PUNAT (L)

Departure at 13h with lunch on board followed by a swimming stop in the crystal clear sea at Bunculuka naturist camp. Cruise to Krk island - the largest of the Croatian islands. Krk has an immense variety in its villages - large and small, gentle green promenades, bare rocky wilderness, tiny islands and hundreds of hidden bays and beaches. Early departure from Rab towards Olib island - situated in the northern part of the Zadar archipelago. Swimming stop in one of the naturist bays. Olib is the only village on this island of the same name and often is a surprise to visitors that there are several valuable archaeological sites dating back to the Roman Empire. Overnight in Olib.

#### Day 4 OLIB - TELAŠĆICA (B, L, CD)

After breakfast and a morning swim, cruise towards Dugi Otok Island and Nature park Telašćica. Due to its intense beauty, richness and importance, this bay surrounded by 13 islands and islets, together with 6 islets inside the bay of Telašćica itself, was proclaimed a Nature Park in 1988 (entrance to be paid on the spot). Time at leisure to explore the white cliffs and lake. Captain's dinner party on board and overnight in Telašćica.

#### Day 5 TELAŠĆICA -MOLAT or ILOVIK (B, L)

An early departure towards Molat or Ilovik island (depending on available space in the small harbours), followed by a swimming stop on the Island of Krava - a Robinson Crusoe type of island where one feels at the call of nature, the return to the almost primeval way of life, the adventurous rhythm of life played by the wind, the sun and the crystal-clear sea. Lunch on board followed by a swimming break on the islands of Krknata, just a few meters away from the island Krava and Dugi otok. Overnight in Molat or Ilovik.

#### Day 6 MOLAT or ILOVIK -MALI LOŠINJ (B, L)

After breakfast and a morning swim, cruise towards island Mali Lošinj with a short stop on llovik, the island of flowers, continuing to Lošinj, known as the "vitality island" and one of the most popular islands on the northern Adriatic, famous for pine trees scent and clear waters. On arrival, take a walk along the harbour front or to Lošinj Aromatic Garden or just visit the picturesque town of Veli Lošinj close by. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

#### Day 7 MALI LOŠINJ - CRES (B, L, D)

After a morning swim, departure towards Cres island, a long and narrow island covered with oak, beech and pine forests as well as vineyards and olive groves. Cres and Mali Lošinj used to be one island but the Romans dug a channel and separated them. A farewell BBQ party on board, a great opportunity for exchanging addresses with other passengers who have by now become new friends. Overnight in Cres.

#### Day 8 CRES - OPATIJA (B)

Early morning departure towards Opatija. Enjoy the fantastic panorama of Opatija Riviera. After breakfast, check out and say farewell to the crew.



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## ITINERARY: FROM SPLIT

#### Day 1 SPLIT - PUČIŠĆA (L)

Departure from Split at 13h followed by lunch and a swimming break at Ruskamen naturist beach situated 6 km from Omiš. Continue to Pučišća on Brač Island, a typical Mediterranean place, situated on the northern side of the Island. This is the cradle of the world famous Brač white stone. Possibility of visiting one of the few stone masonry workshops left in Europe. Enjoy the domestic food, wine and famous olive oil of this coastal village. Overnight in the port of Pučišća.

By the time you reach the deck in the morning, Pučišća will already be behind. After the morning swimming stop in the crystal blue sea near the Mlaska naturist camp, cruise toward Korčula - the birthplace of Marco Polo. Lunch will be served either on the tip of the Pelješac peninsula (near Lovište) or in the quiet bay of Kneža on Korčula island. Afternoon arrival in Korčula for guided sightseeing of this exceptional town. According to legend, Korčula was founded by the Trojan hero Antenor in the 12th century B.C. This island has more legends, tales and monuments than any other. In the evening visit one of many seafront restaurants or enjoy the stunning views of the mainland coast and mountains from the waterfront cafes and bars. Overnight in Korčula.

#### Day 3 KORČULA - LASTOVO (B, L, CD)

Before leaving, we suggest a short morning walk through the open market in Korčula where you can buy fresh fruit to enjoy during the day. Swimming stop at one of the naturist beaches on the tiny island of Badija. The cruise continues towards Lastovo, the furthest inhabited island in Dalmatia, called the Imperial Island. Once docked in Ubli port, there's an opportunity to visit the protected Nature Park or visit the biggest town on the island - Lastovo. The island is surrounded by many smaller islands, with plenty of secluded bays suitable for snorkeling, but also known for many little churches and unusually shaped chimneys. Captain's dinner party on board and overnight in Ubli.

#### Day 4 LASTOVO - RAVNIK (GREEN CAVE) - VIS (B, L)

Early morning departure towards Vis Island, closed to tourists for many years because of its unique geographical position. Vis was a strategic harbour for the navy and due to this isolation it has a special charm of the 'Mediterranean as it once was'. Continue to little Ravnik island, where the Green Cave is situated (entrance to be paid on the spot). After a short swim (weather permitting), sail further to visit the town of Vis, situated on the north-eastern part of the island. Enjoy the walk through the narrow alleys or on one of the pebble beaches with fresh water springs, that stretch along the whole eastern side of this wonderful town rich with history. Overnight in Vis.

#### Day 5 VIS - BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE) -STARI GRAD (B, L)

Early morning cruise towards the little Biševo Island to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon (entrance to be paid on the spot). After a swimming break on one of the beaches on Jerolim Island, cruise towards Stari Grad on Hvar Island, the sunniest Adriatic island. Guided tour of Stari Grad. Time at leisure and overnight in Stari Grad.

#### Day 6 STARI GRAD - BOL (B, L)

Breakfast is followed by a short swimming stop near the naturist camp Nudist in Vrboska. During lunch cruise towards beautiful Brač island and the famous town of Bol. The last day is spent relaxing and swimming in various tranquil bays of Brač Island. Cruise towards Šolta Island with a swimming stop in Livka cove and lunch on board. Late afternoon arrival in Stomorska - a town that immediately wins everybody over with its rustic charm and the hospitality of the locals. Enjoy an evening BBQ party on board. Overnight in Šolta.

Korčula has an abundant choice of restaurants for a great gourmet experience and there are many bars and clubs for those looking for evening entertainment. Overnight in Korčula.

#### Day 7 KORČULA - BOL -MILNA/PUČIŠĆA(B, L, CD)

The final stop will be the Island of Brač and the picturesque town of Bol. Walk along the promenade or swim at one of the most famous beaches in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat (the Golden Horn - known for its gravel promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change their shape). 

In recent years Zadar has added a touch of cool with the famous Sea Organs and "Greeting to the Sun" light installations, both located on the city's waterfront. Watch the fabulous sunset from here. Overnight in Zadar.

#### Day 6 ZADAR - KRKA WATERFALLS / ŠIBENIK (B, T, D)

Cruise towards Skradin, then board a coach. The first stop is the local winery for wine tasting and light tapas lunch. Back in Skradin, walk through the Krka Waterfalls National Park and visit "Skradinski Buk". Jaw-droppingly beautiful, this is the most popular part of the waterfall area. There are 17 waterfalls, with cascades up to 100 m wide, and the Krka river tumbles 45.7 meters. Swimming is allowed in designated areas, bring a bathing suit and enjoy the clear fresh water. Šibenik, our afternoon destination, is situated in the very central part of Croatia's Adriatic coast. Explore the glorious old town, the cultural monuments and the most famous one here, the UNESCOlisted Cathedral of St James. Wander and discover the historic core and waterfront. Dinner on board and overnight in Šibenik.

After breakfast, cruise south to Split, Croatia's second largest city where Roman emperor Diocletian built a retirement palace now under UNESCO protection. Split waterfront is a happening place and there's a buzz along the beautiful wide promenade. A local guide meets us on arrival for a walk through the heart of the bustling old town and the market. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 8 SPLIT - METKOVIĆ (B, L, CD)

Morning cruise to Metković, situated on the banks of the river Neretva, after which the delta is named. Here, mandarins grow by the water channels and we take a barge ride to explore the groves, the flora and fauna, wild birds and the traditional way of life of the Neretva people. Experience a delightful, "time warp" feeling. Narona holds remains of a Roman temple - the Augusteum - and seventeen monumental marble sculptures of Roman emperors and their family members. 





## Belgrade – Novi Sad – Osijek – Vukovar – Zagreb – Plitvice Lakes - Split

## DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN BELGRADE

Upon arrival in Belgrade, transfer to hotel in the city centre. After relaxation time, explore the enchanting city on a captivating walking tour to discover the bohemian atmosphere of Skadarlija and behold the historical marvels of Kalemegdan Fortress, offering panoramic views of the Danube River and the city below. Overnight in Belgrade.

Overnight in Osijek.

Treat yourself to the unique "štrukli" at a traditional bakery or famous Hotel Esplanade before heading to Rastoke, a village nestled amidst enchanting waterfalls. Accommodation and dinner in the Plitvice Lakes region.

## DAY 5 PLITVICE LAKES - SPLIT (250 KM) (B)

Early visit to Plitvice Lakes National Park, offering tranquil paths winding around interconnected lakes adorned with mesmerizing waterfalls. These natural wonders, protected by UNESCO, constitute Croatia's oldest and most renowned national park. Proceed to Split to embark on a Katarina Line Cruise.

After breakfast, depart for Prizren, with stop en route at Kruja hill town, important for Albanian history and for traditional handicraft production. Enjoy the old bazar. Transfer to Prizren, the cradle of cultural wealth of Kosovo people. The walking tour will explore the Old town with its Ottoman bridge, water fountain, their unique mosques and orthodox churches. Overnight in Prizren.

#### Day 5 PRIZREN – FIERZA – KOMAN – SHKODER (ALBANIA) (B)

Breakfast and early departure to Fierza/ Albania. Embark the ferry to enjoy a 2.5-hours sailing on Koman Lake with stunning panoramic views of the Drini River Valley, canyons, waterfalls and amazing rock formations. Upon arrival to Koman, continue driving to Shkoder. Overnight in Shkoder.

## Day 6 SHKODER – CETINJE – NJEGUŠI – KOTOR (MONTENEGRO) (B)

After breakfast, we drive to Cetinje, the old royal capital of Montenegro, a town rich with history and abundant in cultural sights reflecting its important past. Visit the Museum of King Nicolas. Proceed driving to Njeguši village and enjoy local production (ham&cheese). Continue on to enjoy the breathtaking panorama of the Bay of Kotor. Overnight in Kotor.

### Day 7 KOTOR – LADY ON THE ROCK – KOTOR (B)

After breakfast, start with the walking tour of Kotor Old Town (UNESCO Heritage), a magnificent walled medieval city of twisting, pink-paved streets, markets and architecture reflecting Byzantine to Venetian influences. Boat ride to the stunning Islands called St. George and Our Lady of the Rock. Overnight in Kotor.

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### Day 8 KOTOR – MOSTAR (BOSNIA & HERZEGOVINA) (B)

After breakfast, depart to the historic town of Mostar, spanning a deep valley of the Neretva River, developed in the 15th and 16th centuries as an Ottoman frontier town and during the Austro-Hungarian period. Overnight in Mostar.

## Day 9 MOSTAR – SARAJEVO – MOSTAR (B)

After breakfast, drive to Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia & Herzegovina, one of the most oriental and culturally diverse cities in Europe, with over 300 years under Turkish rule until the Austro-Hungarians arrived in the late nineteenth century. Baščaršija is not just a national monument – but a cultural and historical nucleus of Sarajevo and a must-see place for all of those that visit BiH's capital city. Drive back to Mostar. Overnight in Mostar.

## Day 10 MOSTAR - SPLIT (CROATIA) (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and depart to Split.
